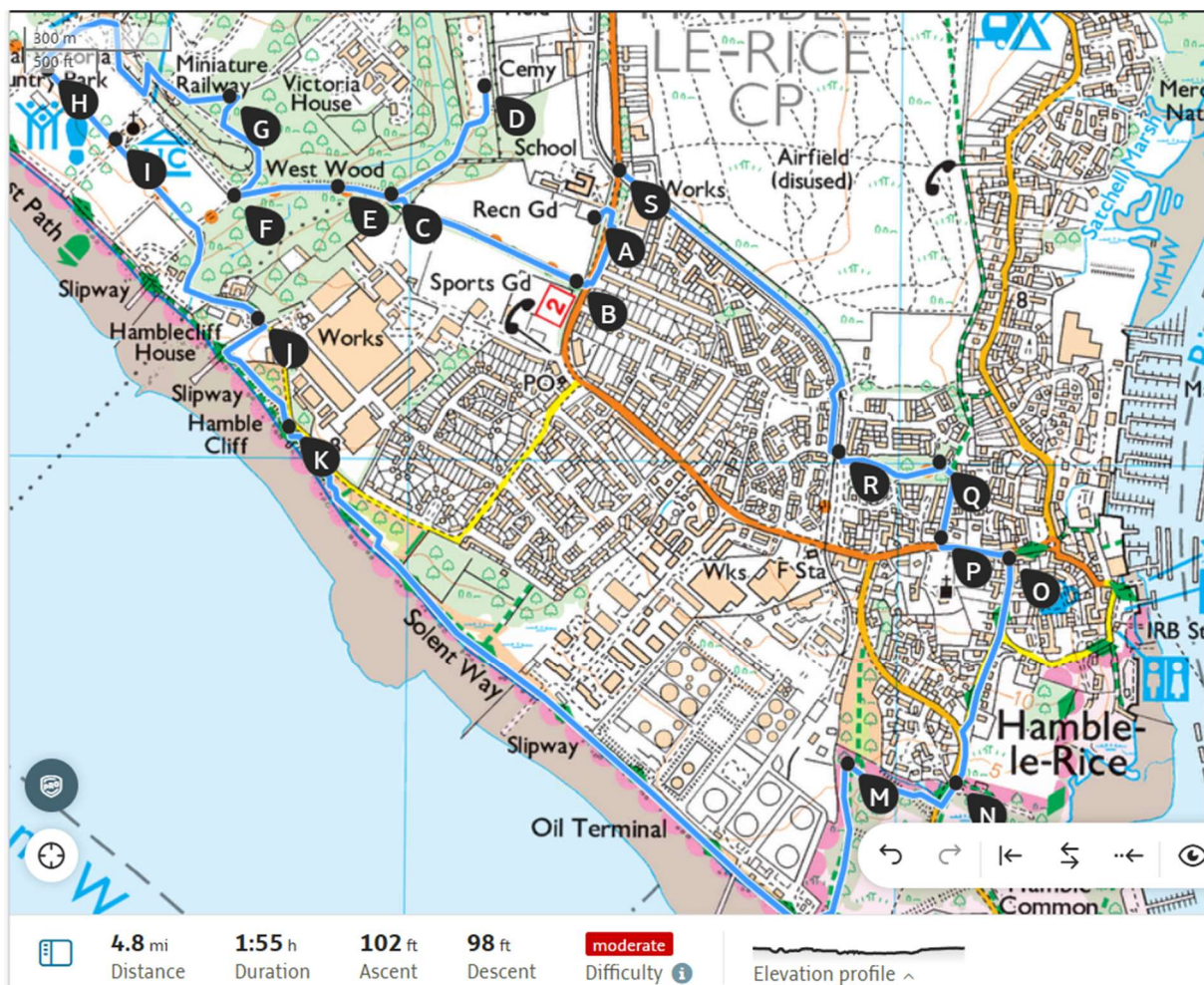


17th March 2026 Walk Brief: Victoria County Park and Hamble-le Rice Rail:

It is proposed we meet at free Mount Pleasant Playing Fields

1030 and then follow the route shown below. We can then

Besides dressing for the weather on the day please all take care on the walk. The main hazards and precautions to be aware include:

- Paths can be slippery and some routes can be muddy so waterproof walking shoes or boots will be needed although this route has been chosen to avoid this as much as possible.
- Care will be needed as paths can be slippery and roots & kerbs etc. are an ever-present tripping, also take care that shoelaces are not likely to trip you. There are road crossings where particular care will be needed
- Please remain between walk leader and tail walker.
- Please bring your membership card with you and check emergency contact information is written on the back of the card.
- Please bring your mobile phone and check you have my number in case of a problem.
