

Walk Brief 10:30 20th January: Lower Hamble & Holly Hill

The walking route is as shown on next page and is about 4.5 miles long.

For the walk on Tuesday 20th January, we will meet at free Car Park in Warsash

We previously did this walk in November 2024

The route has great views across the mouth of the Hamble near the start and then follows the all-weather path up the Hamble River Estuary where there are often many sea birds and very occasionally seals. The second half is mainly through Holly Hill Woodland, the last ½ mile of the walk is along the road back into Warsash.

Please let me know if you can make it and let me know if you want a lift or can offer lifts to others. Also please let me know if you will be staying for lunch.

Besides dressing for the weather on the day some paths can be muddy so waterproof walking shoes or boots may be needed, and a change of footwear will probably be needed before having lunch

Please all take care on the walk. The main hazards and precautions to be aware include:

- Paths can be slippery.
- Tripping hazards from routes, kerbs and rough track are present, also take care that shoelaces are not likely to trip you. A ¼ mile section from River towards Holly Hill needs particular care due to being narrow and with many exposed routes
- Please remain between walk leader and tail walker.
- Please bring your membership card with you and check emergency contact information is written on the back of the card.
- Please bring mobile phone and check you have my number in case of a problem.
